Keeping you informed

Over last few weeks we have completed some electrical works:

- Reinforcement of a radial circuit to a ring circuit to allow additional power socket in Room 7.
- Increased the size of trunking in Copridor 20a to accommodate the extra cable back to the fuseboard.
- Banding of the cables within the plastic trunking (Requirement of the EE Regs.) - identified as an issue for us to address at the last 5 yearly inspection.
- Installing a LED spotlight to shine over the Church steps. We identified this as a Health & Safety Risk when it is dark.

Update regarding the Lift

- The Engineer has attended and found two issues, one part has been replaced successfully but we are awaiting the arrival of another faulty part.
